

1. What is SSL? (Secure Socket Layer)

Answer: This basically means that website you are trying to access is legitimate and secure.

2. How can I tell that the site I'm visiting has an SSL certificate or not?

Answer: If the site does not have an SSL Certificate, on the browser address bar there will have an exclamation mark, or it will state not secure. If the site has an SSL Certificate, the URL will begin with "https" instead of just "http".

3. How can SSL Certificates benefit me?

Answer: SSL secures any traffic between you and the website to ensure that your personal information is safe

4. What are the requirements of SSL?

Answer: You need physical access to the hosting server or access to admin portal of the site, this differs depending on the services you are trying to put SSL certificates on.
